ENHANCEMENT FUNDS

Enhancement Funds support initiatives that improve the quality of student life at AHS. These are opportunities to fund innovation and excellence in areas that benefit one branch or the entire student body.

CDL ENHANCEMENT FUND

SOLD

This fund supports enhancements to the Centre for Diverse Learning (CDL) at AHS, through the Middle School mentorship program AHSConnect and other student-led initiatives to mentor younger students regarding social media, as well as enabling us to retain Child and Youth Workers who support student well-being in our Elementary branches.

TECHNOLOGY FUND

\$250,000 per campus or \$750,000 for all 3 campuses

Technology is a critical aspect of learning in every subject. The role of distance learning has amplified the need to ensure every student is supported and equipped with current. suitable hardware and software.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT FUND \$100,000 per campus or \$300,000 for all 3 campuses

Staying ahead of new innovations and best practices in education requires on-going training and professional development for teaching staff.

STUDENT EXPERIENCE FUND

\$100,000 per campus or \$300,000 for all 3 campuses

This fund supports students from families requiring financial assistance to participate in school trips and programs.

VIRTUAL EXPERIENCE FUND

\$100,000 per campus or \$300,000 for all 3 campuses

This fund makes possible authentic and engaging real-world experiences that draw on local & global resources via the Internet; e.g., museum tours or meeting with artists. poets. etc.

WELLNESS FUND

\$100,000 per campus or \$300,000 for all 3 campuses

This fund is designated for hiring full-time social workers. and offering mindfulness programs. yoga, meditation instructors and other wellness resources.

ATHLETIC FUND

\$100,000 per campus or \$300,000 for all 3 campuses

Our teachers work to ensure that students experience a healthy balance of athletics, are engaged in physical education and activity, and have the opportunity to participate in team competitions. Physical education is an integral piece of our educational programs and we are proud of our players and teams.

TEACHER INNOVATION FUND

\$100,000 per campus or \$300,000 for all 3 campuses

At AHS, we cultivate creativity, in both our students and faculty, and create opportunities to think critically and develop broad ideas, resulting in innovative solutions.

STUDENT LEADERSHIP FUND

\$54,000 per campus or \$162,000 for all 3 campuses

This fund supports student leadership initiatives and related resource development.

TORAH ENANCEMENT FUND

\$54,000 per campus or \$162,000 for all 3 campuses

Torah is the heart of what we do at AHS as a community Jewish school. This fund will enable us to provide enhanced Torah programming for our students, such as the Devash Parsha magazine and Alpha-Beta learning resources, as well as high level professional development for our Torah teachers.
